Peter Lops, shipped in New Bedford
 as steward and shipkeeper, for the 140th day
 gave him \$60 advance before leaving
 home, Wednesday July 28th 1866. He travelled
 taking all his clothes with him, saw
 him ashore but he would not come on board.

took from the Port of St George, as then
 by the name of Peter Brown to go in
 the vessel if he liked. Let him have
 one Jack Knife,
 one Skin Coat.

He left us in a few days, so this is our loss,

Leaves Josa, Shipped in Schooner
 Admiral Blake March 21st 1866 and
 was to go the voyage or leave the vessel
 when we got ready to leave the Island.
 and was to leave the 140th day for the
 time that he stayed on board, May 29th 1866
 gave him his discharge, we had taken
 while he was on board 113 Bbls,
