Ship Edward on A Passage to New Zealand

Saturday October the 21st 1848

these four and twenty hours commence with strong trades from the ESE, the Ship all prudent sail set, standing by the wind to the Southward at 6 PM saw the Island of Korotongo bearing per Compass E by S, Dist 8 Leagues the Middle and Latter part working to the windward to get some men.

Sunday Oct the 22nd 1848

Strong trades and fair weather Ship working up to the Land at 6 PM the Island bore ESE Dist five Leagues, the Middle and Latter part winds the same and the weather pleasant at 12 M the Land bore ESE 10 miles Dist the Ship works heavy
