Commences with fresh trades and fine weather. Ship with all sail set working to the Windward at 4 P.M. A boat with six natives came from the Island, the middle part strong breezes at 8 the Capt went on shore and at 12 the Boat came with some Yams & Fowl &c

Tuesday October the 24th

these 24 hours commences with A pleasant breeze from the E N E and fine weather, at 3 P.M. the Capt came aboard, at 5 P.M. cleared the Island, and set all sail steering South

the middle and latter part fresh breezes and pleasant weather, all drawing sail sat steering South

South Lat 23. 14

Wednesday October the 25th

this day commences with A fine breeze from the E N E and pleasant, course South all hands employed this afternoon bending new sails the middle part light breezes from the N E at 7 A.M. broke out some oil from between Decks to Cooper Ends pleasant &c. Water Lat 24. 44

Thursday October the 26th

all of these 24 hours light air from the Northward and fine pleasant weather the Ship with all sail set steering S by E. Lat By Obs 26. 00 South

Friday October the 27th

the first part light air, and the middle and latter part A fresh breeze from the East. all drawing sail set steering South, Employed repairing sails
