The first part of this four and twenty hours light breezes from the East and cloudy weather, all drawing sail set steering South, the Middle & latter part brisk breezes from the N E and fine weather, the Watch employed repairing sails, nothing of the Whale kind to cheer up the drooping spirits South Lat by Obs 29. 36

Sunday October the 29th

This four and twenty hours commence with light breezes from the Northward, and fine weather the Ship with all drawing sail steering South the middle part hazy at 7 AM saw a fin back the first spout seen for 40 Days. the latter part light breezes and cloudy, the wind inclining to the westward Lat 31. 15 Long 160. 40

Monday October the 30th 1888

Commences with light breezes from the N N W and moderate cloudy weather, all sail set to the Breeze steering South: at 6 PM commenced raining, and took in the top gallant studding sails, the Middle part some rain, the latter part wind S S W and hazy Lat by Obs 32. 55

Tuesday October the 31st

Commences with a fresh breeze from the S S W and the weather some hazy. Ship with all sail set steering by the Wind to the S E, the Middle part light squalls, and at 3 AM furled the fore top gallant sail, and at 9. set the fore & Mizzen top gallant sails, the latter part fresh breezes from the Southward and moderate cloudy weather, Lat. by Obs 34. 08. Long by Chron 160. 55.
