commences with light breezes from the NNE and fine weather. Ship with all sail set steering SE. the middle and latter part the breeze increasing from the NNE and the weather moderate & cloudy. Nothing of the Whales Lat 35.20 Long 144 27

Tuesday November the 14th

all this four and twenty hours light breezes from the northward and fine weather. Ship with all sail set steering SE. the latter part the wind hauling to the Eastward Lat by Obs 36.50 Long by Chron 143.16

Wednesday November the 15th

these 24 hours commences with light breezes from the northeasterly, attended with fair weather. Ship with all sail set steering SE. at 3 PM the wind hauled to the East. took in the Studding sail and braced sharp heading SSE. the middle and latter part strong breezes and hazy weather, No Obs

Thursday November the 16th

commences with strong breezes from the East and hazy ship under all sail standing standing SSE from 6 to 10 PM increasing gales with some rain furled the top gallant sails & flying jib. and from 4 to 8 AM furled the top sails jib & courses and hove the ship too heading to the South under main Spence and fore top mast stay sail the latter part strong gales with rain
