continued A brisk gale from the Westward

the fore top mast Studding sail in A squall.
same time parted the Wheel Rope, rove A new
one and at 4 AM set the Larboard Studding sail
the latter part fresh gales from the W N W
and haze, South Lat 42.01, West Long 125.50

Saturday November the 25th
these 24 hours commenced with Brisk gales from
the W N W, and haze weather, at 8 PM the
wind shifted in A squall from the S W took
in the top gallant sails and the Studding sail
at 12 M N double reefed the top sails, the latter part
strong gales from the S S W, and pleasant weather
Ship under single reef top sails, jib & courses
steering East. go it, my beauty
