first part light breeze from the N^E and fair weather
middle part strong breezes from the north, at 4 AM
furled the top gallant sails and flying jib, at 7 AM
veered ship to the N^E, Ender cold and rugged
Lat 50. 50 Long 56. 09

Thursday Dec^r the 28th

commenced with strong breezes from the N^NW
and rugged weather ship heading to the N^E
at 4 PM the wind hauling to the N^NE, and
veered ship to the N^W, and set top gallant sails
and flying jib, the middle part fine weather
and the latter part heavy S^W Whaler
Lat 49. 49 Long 57. 01 West

Friday Dec^r the 29th

all these 24 hours moderate breezes and fine weather
Lat By Ob 48. 18 Long By Chron 58. 38

Saturday Dec^r the 30th

A continuation of light adverse winds from the North
and the weather good. Nothing of the Whale kind

Sunday Dec^r the 31st 1848

the first of these 24 hours fresh breezes from
the Westward, with fair weather, course N^NW
Lat By Ob 46. 38 S. Long By Chron 59. 39 West
the middle and latter part of the day fresh breezes and heavy
at 10 AM set shortened sail for the night, in hopes of seeing
Sperm Whaler, thus ends the year 1848
