Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> light breezes from  
the E or E, the Land in sight bearing West  
Dist 35 miles. at 7 P M the wind hauling  
to the Northward, tacked Ship and headed  
up E by S. Lat By Obs 6.20 Long By Chron  
34.26  
Bad winds attend us

Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of February 1849  
the first and middle part of this day calm  
and very warm, at 4 P M A light breeze from the  
E or E, Ship heading to the North, at sun set set the  
Main Royal, one sail in sight from the mast head  
to the S W, Lat 5.55 S, Long 34.19 West

Wednesday the 21<sup>st</sup> of February  
light wind from the East and fair  
weather Ship steering N by W  
at 2 P M spoke the Barge Agnes  
of and for New York 21 Days from Rio  
Lat By Obs 4.36 Long 34.40

Thursday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of February  
Steady Trades and fine weather, Ship steering  
N N W with all sail set. A current here  
setting to the Westward one mile per hour  
Lat By Obs 2.53 Long By Chron 36.24
