Tuesday March the 6<sup>th</sup>  
all this day light breeze from the Westward  
and fair weather, Ship with all sail set  
standing to the N<sup>W</sup>, Watch employed painting  
and boiling the black fish, Lat 15.52  
Long 51.25

Wednesday March the 7<sup>th</sup> 1849  
this day fresh breezes from the N<sup>W</sup> by W  
with a large swell coming from the South  
the Ship with all sail set standing to the Southward  
at 6 PM saw a sail standing S<sup>S</sup>W  
Lat by Obs 17.43 Long by Chron 51.22

Thursday March the 8<sup>th</sup>  
A fresh breeze from the N<sup>W</sup> by W and  
fair weather Ship under all sail heading  
North and on by E Lat by Obs 19.17  
Long by Chron 51.03

Friday March the 9<sup>th</sup>  
the first part calm, the Middle  
and latter part light breeze from  
the Westward, Lat 19.36 Long 51.28
