 the day with fine weather and at 12
 made all sails and saw schooner John Manta
 and spot schooner John Manta so end
 latitude 37.00 long 73.29

Saturday 12
 the day with strong SW winds and vessels
 under shot sails saw John Manta so end
 latitude 37.48 long 74.05

Sunday 13
 the day with strong SW winds and vessels under
 shot sails with Cape Sea rather poor modest
 so end the day latitude 37.40 long 73.22

Monday 14
 the day with fine weather winds from SW
 and made all sails and at 3 p.m. Rised
 one by Scull of whals in stream and leave
 S.B. the boat and S.B. Struck and got one
 bring long suit and turn out from
 stream so end SW schooner John Manta
 latitude 37.00 long 72.58

Thursday 15
 the day with calm and stand to Caithney
 the whals and fens at 8 a.m. and stand the
 works in latter part breeze from East vessels
 under shot sails saw 5 master schooner so end
 latitude 37.20 long 72.19

Wednesday 16
 the day with calm and light breeze and at 10 a.m.
 saw W.M. groger with boat down and we
 drop boat and we got 2 whals beat Remond
 above night long suit stand down the oil
 latitude 37.30 long 71.21

 the day with fine weather and stand to
 Caithney and fens at 8 a.m. and stand
 the works saw one whaling schooner so all
 lander enflung in the works so end
 latitude 37.55 long 70.20

Friday 18
 the day with fine weather winds from N.W. SW
 and enflung in bailing at 10 a.m. Rised
 Scull of 8 p.m. whals and dargo boat and
 S.B. boat went on and got fast and fell
 them bring long suit and Caithney in get
 down at 2.30 p.m. and same stand down
 saw cleaning the Casde so end the day
 latitude 38.10 long 70.43

Saturday 19
 the day with fine weather and fens bailing
 at 7 a.m. and latter part comes to stand down
 the oil so end the day so end the day
 latitude 38.00 long 71.23

Sunday 20
 the day with strong breeze and Cape Sea
 vessels under shot sails so end
 latitude 37.40 long 72.22

Monday 21
 the day with fine weather made all sail
 Caithney and saw one 5 master schooner
 one steamer so end the day
 latitude 37.24 long 73.11

Thursday 22
 the day with very good winds and saw 2 schooner
 Chasenz the whals and saw S. B. Caithney
 and John Manta so end the day
 latitude 36.27 long 74.16
