Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup>

This day Began With Strong S. W. Wind With tided  
 Storm stood various tacks under Short Sail  
 middle and latter Part steering various course  
 With all Sail out Saw one Sail and Black  
 Ship at Sun Set took in Sail So end of this  
 Day

Sunday July 1<sup>st</sup> 1906
