 Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup> 1906

This day began with strong S. W. Wind steering  
 S. E. with all sail out so ends of this day  
 Lat 35.51 N. Long 65.36. W

Thursday July 5<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong S. W. Wind steering  
 S. E. with all sail out middle and latter  
 parts light southerly Wind heading by the  
 Wind to S. E. E. so ends of this day  
 Lat 35.07. N. Long 62.54. W

Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light southerly Wind  
 heading S. S. E. with all sail out at 11.00  
 A. M. Charles Elizabeth reared sperm  
 whale run for them but the whales went out  
 eight to leeward so stood by the Wind to  
 S. S. W. with all sail out so ends of this day  
 Lat 35.24. N. Long 61.37. W

Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup>

This day began with S. S. E. Wind heading to  
 S. S. W. with all sail out latter parts heading  
 S. E. E. saw several merchant vessel  
 so ends of this day  
 Lat 34.17 N. Long 61.07. W

Sunday July 8<sup>th</sup>

This day began with S. S. E. Wind  
 heading S. by W. with all sail out latter  
 part heading S. E. E. with all sail out saw  
 one merchant ship and one steamer bound  
 N. W. so ends of this day  
 Lat 33.49. N. Long 60.13. W

This day began with light S. S. E. Wind with  
 showers of rain heading by the Wind to eastward  
 with all sail out so ends of this day  
 Lat 33.48. N. Long 58.41. W

Tuesday July 10<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S. S. E. Wind with  
 showers of rain heading by the Wind to eastward  
 with all sail out middle and latter parts heavy  
 rain squalls so ends of this day  
 Lat 33.18. N. Long 56.53. W

Wednesday July 11<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S. S. E. Wind with rain  
 squalls heading to eastward with all sail out at  
 11. A. M. Edmunds bean reared lone whale  
 but boat ready and Lored at 4.00 P. M.  
 Boat come on board whale went out sight  
 so ends of this day

Thursday July 12<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light easterly Wind  
 heading S. S. E. with all sail out  
 middle and latter parts heading east  
 so ends of this day  
 Lat 33.50. N. Long 55.30. W

This day began with light S. S. E. Wind  
 heading east with all sail out middle  
 and latter parts strong S. E. Wind with  
 heavy rain squalls heading S. S. W.  
 with parts of all sail out so ends of  
 this day
