Sunday July 15th

This day began with Strong S. E. Wind lay
With two Whaler along Side at 6.00 A. M. Stand
on cutting at 10.00 A. M. finish Middelby and
Latter Part employed at Boyling So ends of
This day
Lat 33.37. N. Long 54.15. W

Monday July 16th

This day began with Strong S. E. Wind
With rain Squall heading E. By. N. Employ
on Boyling at 3.30 P. M. finish and set all
Sail Middelby and latter Part heading S. E.
So ends of this day
Lat 33.41. N. Long 53.16. W

Tuesday July 17th

This day began with Light S. E. W. Wind heading
S. E. With all Sail out at day Light commence slow
At 10.00 finish Middelby and latter Part heading
to S. E. Spoke to Bark Bertha of New Bedford
So ends of this day
No Ob.

Wednesday July 18th

This day began with light S. W. Wind heading S. E. By S
With Part of all Sail out at 4.00 P. M. Bark Bertha
raised large Whal and struck lost at Sun set
Boat come on Board with out success So ends of this day
No Ob.

Thursday July 19th 1906

This day began with light S. W. Wind heading
S. E. under short Sail Middelby and latter Part
Northley Wind with rain Squall Steered various course
With all Sail out at Sun set took in Sail two Whalman
in Sight So ends of this day
Lat 32.18. N. Long 50.08. W

Friday July 20th

This day began with light Northley Wind with
rain Squall heading E. N. E. under short Sail
Middelby Part set all Sail at 2.00 P. M. Mr Lopez
raised Sperm Whaler L. B. Struck at 7.30 P. M.
Took Whal along Side So ends of this day one
Whalman in Sight So
No Ob.

Saturday July 21st

This day began with light S. E. Wind with
rain Squall employed on cutting at 7.25 got
True of this Border and heading Laying along
Side one Whalman in Sight So ends of this day
No Ob.

Sunday July 22nd

This day began with light Southley Wind
at 4.25 A. M. commence cutting no head at
10.00 A. M. got the gunk on Deck all the
care in to hook on the chain Part lost the care
Middelby and latter Part all hands
Employed at Work So ends of this day
Lat 32.36 N. Long
