Wednesday August 1st 1906

This day began with light E. S. E. heading to South with all sail set middley and latter part stood various tacks at Sun set took in sail so end of this day

Thursday August 2nd

This day began with light E. N. E. Wind heading S. E. with part of all sail out middley and latter part stood various tacks with all sail out at Sun set took in sail so end of this day

Lat 32.43. N. Long 45.43. W

Friday August 3rd

This day began with light E. N. E. Wind with rain squall at day light in all sail stood various tack middley and calm took in all sail latter part light E. N. E. Wind and calm so end of this day

Saturday August 4th

This day began with calm employed at ship duty middley and latter part light Westley Wind steered various course with all sail out at Sun set took in sail saw one merchant bark so end of this day

Sunday August 5th

This day began with light Westley Wind with rain squall stood various tacks with all sail out at Sun set took in sail latter part light E. N. E. Wind and calm so end of this day

Monday August 6th 1906

This day began with light E. N. E. Wind and calm heading S. E. under short sail middley and latter part stood various tacks with all sail out at Sun set took in sail so end of this day

Lat 35.21. N. Long 43.13. W

Tuesday August 7th

This day began with light E. N. E. Wind and calm middley part light S. E. Wind heading East with all sail out at 6th 30 P. M. headward raised large whale got the boat ready did not see whale in more hook in sail so end of this day

Wednesday August 8th

This day began with light S. E. Wind and calm middley part light breeze from S. E. late all sail at 7th 00 P. M. Sunell raised large whale lowered boat at 8th 30 P. M. come on board with out success did not see the whale any more so took in sail so end of this day

Thursday August 9th

This day began with light S. E. Wind heading E. N. E. with all sail out middley and latter part heading S. E. at Sun set took in sail saw two steamers so end of this day
