This day began with Strong S. W. Wind heading S. S. E. under Short Sail Middle and Latter Part Blown Gale from S. W. laying to under Reef Trysail and Foreday sail Saw two Steamers Bound West so ends of this day

This day began with heavy Gale from S. W. Laying to under reef Trysails and Foreday sail Middle and Latter Part Wind all to N. W. with heavy rain Squalls and Ship much Water so ends of this day
