Steering N. W. with part of all sail out

Heading North So end of this day

North with all sail out middle and latter
part heavy rain squalls So end of this day

Friday Nov 9th

This day began with strong S. E. Wind heading
North by N. with part of all sail out middle
and latter part blown heavy from N. E. with
heavy rain squalls heading N. N. W. under
short sail saw one merchant ship bound South
So end of this day

Saturday Nov 10th

This day began with strong S. E. Wind with
heavy rain squall heading N. N. W. under
short sail middle and latter part blown
heavy and rug steering S. S. W. under short
sail So end of this day

and rug steering S. S. W. under short sail
middle and latter part blown heavy Gale
from Northerly and heavy sea running
Laying to under reef Tri rails So end of
