various tack with Part of all sail out
at 2th 20. P. M. Whale Went Out Light to
Windward at Sun Set took in sail

with heavy Sea running from North heading
S. S. E. under Trawl middle Part light
Breeze from S. W. Stood various tack with
Part of all sail out at 4th 00. P. M. David
raised Lone Spamer Whaler got Boat ready
and Lower the Boat at 4.30. P. M. come on
Board with out success and took in sail

under Short sail middle and Latter moderate
Gale all sail Stood various tack at Sun Set
took in sail Saw one merchant ship So End of
this day

Lat 20.07. Long 35.36. W

Sunday Nov 18th

Whale This day began with Strong Easterly Wind
Heading S. S. E. under Short sail at daylight
Set all sail and Stood various tack at 11.30.
A. M. Mr Loper raised Sparm Whaler at 1.15
P. M. Lowered Boat at 5.30. P. M. took three
Whale to the ship. L. B. one. S. B. two. at Dark
Got ready Whaler Laying along Side
So End of this day
