This day began with light S. E. Wind heading N. E. under short sail middle and latter parts stood various tacks with part of all sail out at Sun late took in sail so end of this day

Wednesday Dec 5th

This day began with strong E. S. E. Wind with rain squalls heading S. under short sail middle and latter parts stood various tacks with part of all sail out at Sun late took in sail so end of this day
Lat 16.50. S. Long 36.04. W

Thursday Dec 6th

This day began with strong Northerly Wind with rain squalls heading East under short sail middle and latter part stood various tacks with part of all sail out one merchant ship in sight so end of this day
