 with rain squalls middle and latter parts stood
 various tacks with part of all sail out at
 Sun late took in sail so ends of this day

Monday Dec 17th
 This day began with light N. E. wind with
 rain squalls stood various tacks with part of
 all sail out middle and latter parts strong
 breeze from east saw several fish boats and
 land so ends of this day
 Lat 15.47. S. Long 38.46. W

Tuesday Dec 18th
 This day began with strong easterly wind
 heading S. E. with part of all sail out
 middle and latter parts light S. E. wind
 stood various tacks with all sail out so ends
 of this day

Wednesday Dec 19th
 This day began with light S. E. wind with
 calm heading S. by W. with all sail out middle
 part heavy rain squalls latter part strong
 breeze heading North east under short sail
 saw several steamers so ends of this day
 Lat 16.37. S. Long 37.45. W

 This day began with strong S. E. wind with heavy
 rain squalls heading N. E. middle and latter parts
 stood various tacks with all sail out at Sun late
 took in sail so ends of this day
 Lat 17.21. S. Long 36.58. W

Friday Dec 21st
 This day began with strong easterly with rain
 squalls middle and latter parts stood various
 tacks with part of all sail out at Sun late took
 in sail so ends of this day
 Lat 17.78. S. Long 36.45. W

Saturday Dec 22nd
 This day began with strong S. E. wind
 with rain squalls heading N. E. with part of
 all sail out middle and latter parts heavy
 squalls at Sun late took in sail so ends
 of this day
 Lat 16.45. S. Long 36.46. W

Sunday Dec 23^d
 This day began with strong N. E. wind
 with heavy rain squalls heading S. E. E.
 under topsails middle and latter parts more
 moderate so ends of this day
 Lat 17.25. S. Long 35.56. W

Monday Dec 24th
 This day began with strong N. E. wind
 heading S. E. by E. with part of all sail
 out stood various tacks at 2⁴ 30. P. M. Mr Lopez
 raised large Spanish late all sail and took the
 ship to him at Sun late haler went out sight
 to the windward and took in sail so ends of this day
 Lat 17.09. S. Long 35.36. W
