

Remark on Board Schooner E. B. Connell

Tuesday December 25th 1906

Whaler
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This day began with Strong E. N. E. Wind heading North at day Light saw Bark Platina of New Bedford run for her at 7^h 35. A. M. Edward raised Long Whale Platina Drop her Boat and we all so lowered our Boat at 11^h 30 Bark Struck so the Boat came on Board with out Success At Sun Set took in Sail so end of this day
Lat 17.14. S. Long 35.44. W.

Wednesday Dec 26th

This day began with Light E. N. E. Wind heading North middle and latter part fine weather stood various tack with all sail out at Sun Set took in sail saw one Steamer Bound North so end of this day
Lat 16.50. S. Long 35.36. W.

Thursday Dec 27th

This day began with E. N. E. Wind heading North under Short sail middle and latter part Light Wind with rain Squalls steering various course with part of all sail out at Sun Set took in sail so end of this day
Lat 17.14. S. Long 35.56. W.

Friday Dec 28th

This day began with E. N. E. Wind heading S. E. under Short sail middle and latter part stood various tack under Short so end of this day
Lat 17.34. S. Long 36.01. W.

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Saturday December 29th 1906

This day began with Strong E. N. E. Wind with rain Squalls heading North under Short sail middle and latter part stood various tack with all sail out at Sun Set took in sail saw one Steamer Bound North so end of this day
Lat 17.18. S. Long 36.04. W.

Sunday Dec 30th

This day began with Light E. S. E. Wind heading N. E. under Short sail at Day light had all sail out 7^h 25. A. M. Edward raised two Long Whales going quick to the Windward Work the vessel up to him at 8^h 30 A. M. lowered the Boat at 11^h 30 A. M. the Boat came on Board with out Success Whaler went out sight to the Windward At Sun Set took in sail so end of this day
Lat 17.28. S. Long 35.43. W.

Monday Dec 31st

This day began with Light E. N. E. Wind heading North under Short sail middle and latter part stood various tack with part of all sail out at Sun Set in sail saw one Merchant Ship Bound North so end of this day
Lat 17.14. S. Long 35.39. W.

Tuesday January 1st 1907

This day began with Strong easterly Wind heading S. S. E. under Short sail middle and latter part stood various tack with all sail out at Sun Set took in sail saw Steamer so end of this day
Lat 17.14. S. Long 35.34. W.
