 to end of this day

Tuesday Feb 12th
 This day began with light tiring Wind
 and rain squalls middle and latter parts
 strong N.E. Wind heading North under short
 sail to end of this day
 Lat 5° 39' N. Long 29° 12' W.

Wednesday Feb 13th
 This day began with strong tread Wind
 heading North under short sail middle
 and latter parts steering N.W. under short sail
 to end of this day

 This day began with strong tread Wind with rain
 squalls steering N.W. under short sail middle
 and latter parts rough with rain to end of this day

 heavy sea running steering N.W. under short
 sail middle and latter moderate to end of this day
 No. Obs

Saturday Feb 16th
 This day began with strong tread Wind steering
 N.W. with part of all sail out middle and
 latter parts steering N.W. by N.
 to end of this day
 Lat 7° 50' N. Long 34° 45' W.

Sunday Feb 17th
 This day began with strong tread Wind
 with heavy sea running steering N.W. by N.
 with part of all sail out middle and latter
 parts heavy rain fall to end of this day
 No. Obs

Monday Feb 18th
 This day began with strong tread Wind with
 heavy rain steering N.W. by N. under short
 sail middle and latter parts rough
 to end of this day
 Lat 9° 26' N. Long 36° 50' W.
