Sick At 3:50 Amushed Bozling latter part moderate
Heavy rain and C. E. Wind at 2nd 20 P. M. in
Storm Down Oil So ends of this day

Saturday May 18th

This day began with fresh C. E. Wind with
Heavy rain heading C. E. W. under short sail
middle and latter parts blown strong from
W. S. W. two whalman in sight and one shot
So ends of this day

3. Name This day began with strong W. S. W. Wind
of Duty Heading C. E. by W. with part of all sail out
Sick Middle and latter parts stood various tacks with
part of all sail out at Sun late took in sail
saw one steamer so ends of this day

Monday May 20th

This day began with strong S. W. Wind Laying
under short sail middle and latter parts
All sail stood various tacks at Sun late
took in sail so ends of this day

under short sail middle and latter parts
Saw from S. W. with heavy sea running from
South Laying under reef tricsails ship much
water so ends of this day

middle part blown heavy with sea running from
S. W. Laying under tricsails latter part more
moderate head to South so ends of this day
