Wednesday June 26
 the day with smoky weather winds from
 SW. and we got under way from anchoring for
 see at 3 p.m. we was off 15 miles
 off west of Koman's land under all
 sail so end the day

Thursday June 27
 the day with strong breeze from
 WSW and sail under shaft sail
 hard day SW and saw 2 steamers
 so end the day
 latitude 39.40
 long 70.19

Friday June 28
 the day with calm and light
 breeze and sail under all sail
 enplacing in ship duty so end

latitude 38.14
 long 70.24
