

Journal Long Beach apr
Schooner E. B. Cornell

Sunday July 21 the 1907
the day with fair Sea winds from NW
and Sea from South wassail under
Schut sail saw one whaling schooner
So. end the latitude 37.20 long 74.00

Monday July 22
the day with fine weather winds from
North at 6 a.m. saw Schooner M.M.A. grozer
with boat down and we made all sail
also schooner Ellen A. Swift and grozer
struck the whale grozer got 2 whales
and we gave Schus tel 7.30 p.m.
whales going Crib to meander so boat
came broad so end the day
latitude 37.06 long 74.06

Thursday July 23
fast part of the day with strong breeze
from SW wassail under Schut sail in
latter part Calm fair Sea so
Schooner Ellen A. Swift in sight
So. end the day latitude 36.57 long 74.00

Wednesday July 24
the day with fine weather and beat all sails and
at 8 a.m. saw Ellen A. Swift with boat down
and one for boat got fast and we drop
2 boats down and whales straddled towards
Crib so boat got broad at 11 a.m. So. end
latitude 36.50 long 73.44

Journal Long Beach
Thursday July 25 the 1907
the day with fine weather and made all
sail and at 8 a.m. Rased Skull small
whales and drop 2 boats and strack
S.B. got 2 whales and L.B. got one and
bring them long sail and at 1.00 p.m.
strad to cutting the whale so at 5 p.m.
got broad so made all sail so get off
stream so all explaining in duty so end
latitude 36.44 long 73.19.

Friday July 26
the day with strong breeze from SW and
with fair Sea and wassail under Schut
sails explaining in bailing so end the day
latitude 37.04 long 73.58

Saturday July 27
the day with strong breeze and land light
from NW and fenesch bailing at 1.20 a.m.
and stranded on the oil in latter part
Calm with fair Sea and wassail
under tow traisails So. end the day
latitude 36.48 long 74.24

Sunday July 28
the day with fine weather and made all sails
strad to South and at 8 a.m. Capt. Rased
Skull up. Spam whales and L.B. went on
got faster and here parted from whales
and whales strad to meander Crib so
boat came broad going so end
latitude 36.25 long 74.04
