

Dec 18 at 6 A.M. took our anchor bound to St. Marks at 8 spoke the ship's quakers of new year's
18 days out bound to New Orleans we got some little
papers from New York so end with strong wind at St.

Dec 21 at 3 P.M. came to anchor at St. Marks light
we had a long passage owing to light wind and calms
Dec 22 at 6 A.M. took our oil on shore and supplied
the light with about 450 gallons of oil it is a fixed light
of 13 lamps it is good landing at high water but
at low tide it is very bad owing to a long muddy
flat and no time to passable it was a great water
about 8 feet high at 11 A.M. came on board and
took our anchor bound to Dry Island light with a
strong N.W. wind so ends these 24 hours

Dec 22 at 4 P.M. came to anchor at Dry Island

Dec 23 lying at anchor it being Sunday nothing to do

Dec 24 at 6 A.M. took our oil on shore and supplied the
light with 400 gallons of oil latter part employed filling
oil it being head wind and blowing heavy Dry Island
light is a revolving light of 14 lamps

Dec 25 at 6 took our anchor bound to St. George Island
with fair wind distant 20 miles at 10 came to anchor
and took our oil on shore and supplied the light with
575 gallons of oil it is a fixed light of 14 lamps at 2 P.M.
returned and took our anchor bound to St. Marks distant 18
miles

Dec 26 at 4 A.M. let go our anchor at St. Marks
took our oil on shore and supplied the light with 575
gallons of oil it is a fixed light with 13 lamps it has got
a red space round the middle of the house to distinguish
it at 8 P.M. returned took the anchor and made sail
for Pensacola distant about 100

Dec 27 at 12 A.M. came to anchor at Pensacola took
our oil on shore and supplied the light with
325 gallons of oil here we have it to reach up a very
steep sand hill this is a revolver of 10 lamps
at 3 P.M. returned to our anchor bound to Sand
Island at the entrance to Mobile Bay distant 45 miles

Dec 28 at 8 A.M. came to anchor at Sand Island
took our oil on shore and supplied the light with
325 gallons of oil at 11 A.M. returned and took our
anchor bound to Mobile point distant one league
Sand Island is a fixed light of 15 lamps

Dec 28 at 1 P.M. let go our anchor at Mobile point
took our oil on shore and supplied the light
with 400 gallons of oil it is a revolver of 21 lamps
at 6 returned took our anchor bound up the bay
to Mobile distant 14 miles at 8 let go the anchor
owing to light air and strong current so ends
