

Jan 12 at 5 P.M. the schooner new year came along side and we put the oil board and at 8 she made sail bound up the Lake to supply those lights

Sunday Jan 18 Laying at anchor at pass christian with strong breeze at the midward and ends the 24 hours

Jan 21 Laying at anchor at pass christian rainy weather at 9 A.M. the new year returned from off the Lake came along side and discharged the oil and at 10 took our anchor and moved over to Ship island and came to anchor so ends these 24 hours with thick weather

Jan 22 pleasant weather and strong winds at 7 A.M. took our anchor and moved over to Chandeliers island and supplied the light with 325 gallons of oil it is a fixed light of 3 lamps at 1 P.M. went on shore for some wood at 5 returned took our anchor bound to the N.E. pass of the Mississippi river so ends fine weather

Jan 23 at 11 A.M. came to the anchor at the N.E. pass at 1 P.M. took our oil on shore supplied the light with 700 gallons of oil it is a fixed light of 30 lamps at 6 returned so ends thick weather

Jan 24 at 8 A.M. took our anchor and run down to the South pass at 11 A.M. came to anchor about 12 miles from the light took our oil in to the boat and at 10 A.M.

the boat left for the light and supplied the light with 500 gallons of oil it is a revolve of 14 lamps at 12 at night the boat returned so ends thick weather

Jan 25 at 6 A.M. took our anchor and run down to the S.W. pass at 9 came to anchor off the light at 10 took the oil on shore supplied the light with 775 gallons of oil it is a fixed light of 22 lamps at 6 P.M. returned so ends with thick weather

Jan 26 Laying at anchor at the S.W. pass employed in filling water and getting wood so ends thick weather

Jan 27 Laying at anchor at S.W. pass it being Sunday nothing doing so ends thick weather

Jan 28 Laying at the S.W. pass it being rainy not much doing so ends

Jan 29 the 24 hours fine weather and strong winds at 7 A.M. took our anchor bound to point Peiron at 10 P.M. came to anchor about 3 miles from the light so ends fine weather

Jan 30 at 8 A.M. took our oil on shore and supplied the light with about 200 gallons of oil at 1 P.M. took our anchor bound to Vermilion Bay at 5 P.M. came to anchor about 6 miles from the light so ends fine weather
