

Remarks on board Ship Eliza Adams
Cruising off. Tristan

80 Saturday December 6th

This 24 hours quite moderate weather from the westward under lower top sails & Fore sail heading to the Southward at 4 P.M. Damped with the Bk. Cicero so ends the day

81 Sunday Dec 7th

This day commenced with a fresh Gale from the Southward at 7 A.M. saw a sail and at 2 P.M. took in the St. & Miffen top sail blowing a storm at 7 P.M. Gased wing the M. top sail lying to on the Port tack

82 Monday Dec 8th

Fore part of this day more moderate at 8 A.M. Mr. Bosley rose Wright Whales hove in chase returned on board at 11 A.M. with out success Fin backs in sight sun down took in upper top sails & main sail latter part strong breezes from the N.W. saw one sail

83 Tuesday Dec 9th

This day commenced with strong breezes from N.W. with a very heavy swell running under lower top sails saw the Ship Kiger to the leeward and a Bk. to the windward saw Fin backs so ends the day

Wednesday December 10th

This 24 hours moderate breezes from N.W. saw Wright Whales at 8 A.M. going to the windward did not lower for them saw the Ship Kiger to the windward with all 4 Boats dunn and at 3 P.M. rose Wright Whales again working to the windward did not lower latter part wind the same under top sails and courses working to the westward

Thursday Dec 11th

Fore part of this day light breezes from N.W. on open tacks saw Fin backs also the Ship Kiger sun down took in the light sails and courses so ends the day with strong breezes and rain

Friday Dec 12th

This day commenced with a Gale from N.W. at 5 A.M. lying to under lower M. top sail at 11 A.M. took in main top sail blowing a storm so ends the day Barometer 28.00

Saturday Dec 13th

Fore part of this day blowing a heavy Gail from N.W. with out rain at 3 P.M. set the main top sail latter part continues the same

Sunday Dec 14th

Fore part of this day moderated down to a strong breeze under lower top sails & Fe sail at 3 P.M. Damped with the Ship Kiger so ends the day barometer 29.50 at 6 P.M. wind from about N.E.W.
