- 200 Sunday April 4th
Weather pleasant and watch on
shore the Man of war went out
the Sarah D. Hall came in
- 201 Monday April 5th
Weather moderate Employed at
various jobs
- 202 Tuesday April 6th
Weather quite pleasant took some
water the Man of war sailed all the
Mander and Beaufort so ends the day
- 203 Wednesday April 7th
Weather pleasant several vessels passing
the Bay Head went out and the
Peters came in finished taking
water so ends the day
- 204 Thursday April 8th
Weather pleasant finished stowing
the whole the Bk Beaufort off &
on also one Dutch ship came
in so ends the day Starboard Watch
on liberty. The Maria & Mary Francis
sailed
- 205 Friday April 9th
Weather sun & rain the Port Watch on
liberty the Bk Stafford sailed
Employed painting Boats

- 206 Saturday April 10th
Weather pleasant the Starboard
Watch on liberty several Whalers off & on
also the Bk Fulcrum employed at
various jobs, sailed Schooner Little Beard
- 207 Sunday April 11th
Weather sun & rain the Port Watch on
liberty the Bk Petrel came in at anchor
sailed one merchant ship so ends the day
- 208 Monday April 12th
Light pleasant weather several Whalers
off & on 2 merchant ships came in
employed taking some of the Peigging
so ends the day
- 209 Tuesday April 13th
Light pleasant weather the remainder
of the water also the Morgan & Mary
Francis sailed and cattle so ends the day
WENT ON SHORE
- 210 Wednesday April 14th
Light pleasant weather the Bk Grapround
and one Man of war came in and several
merchant ships coming & going so ends the day
Bk Luiseia sailed WENT ON SHORE
- 211 Thursday April 15th
Strong weather ships passing the Island
the American Brig sailed also the
Bk Sea Ranger & Bk Hercules came in to
anchor so ends the day
