

Remarks on board Ship Eliza Adams

388 Tuesday October 12th Lat 20° 31' Long 29° 16' W
Light breeze with fine shower of rain
under all sail Steering W by N latter part
calm

389 Wednesday Oct 13th
This day had light breeze from S.E.
Steering W by N. so ends the day with
fine weather

390 Thursday Oct 14th
Fore part of this day fresh breeze under
all sail Steering W by N sun down took
in the light sails

391 Friday Oct 15th Lat 20° 31' Long 29° 16' W
This day light fine weather Steering
W by N at day sighted Trinidad
also one merchantman at sundown
Trinidad N. bearing South Dist 4 miles
so ends the under all sail Steering W. N. W.

392 Saturday Oct 16th
This day under all sail with fresh breeze
and light squalls Steering N. W. by W
and 2 sails also got four water

393 Sunday Oct 17th Lat 19° 00' Long 28° 43' W
Fore part of this day fresh breeze from
N.E. under all sail Steering N. W. by W
and Fin back

394 Monday October 18th Lat 18° 20' Long 34° 33' W
Fresh breeze ship under Top sails on
opposite tack weather some squally latter
part had heavy rain also saw fore
Schooner

395 Tuesday Oct 19th
Light breeze from S.E. ship on opposite
tack weather pleasant so ends the day under
short sail

396 Wednesday Oct 20th Lat 18° 20' Long 34° 33' W
Light breeze from S.E. ship on opposite tack
and took sail hauled to the S.E. Employed
Bent a second head of No. 1 sail and a
New No. 1 sail so ends the day under short
sail

397 Thursday Oct 21st Lat 20° 16' Long 34° 53' W
This 24 hours had fresh breeze from
S.E. under all sail heading S by E
and 4 sails Employed making spinn-yarn
so ends the day under Top sails & cover
heading S. S. E.

398 Friday Oct 22nd
Fore part of this day strong breeze from
S.E. heading S by E compass S.E. under
Top sails & cover latter part weather thick
and rainy Steering S. S. E.

399 Saturday Oct 23rd
This 24 hours under all sail Steering
S.E. with strong breeze from the North
bent a new No. 1 Stay sail so ends
the day weather quite pleasant
