412 Friday November 5th Lat Long S W
 This day weather more moderate ship
 under Top sails on opposite tack so ends
 the day under short sail

413 Saturday Nov 6th
 Fore part of this 24 hours light weather
 under all sail weather pleasant &
 caught a Porpoise so ends the day under short
 sail

414 Sunday Nov 7th
 Light pleasant weather from N.W. under
 all sail on opposite tack so ends the day
 under short sail

415 Monday Nov 8th Lat 26-18 Long 36-26
 This 24 hours continues calm

416 Tuesday Nov 9th
 This day commences with fine light
 weather from north and ship backs all
 sail one sail bound E by S ends the day
 under short sail

417 Wednesday Nov 10th
 This day commences with a fresh gale from N.W.
 got out water latter part came in stormy
 ship under lower Top sails so ends the day

418 Thursday November 11th Lat Long S W
 Fore part of this day strong breezes from
 S.S.W. under Top sails latter part
 more moderate and fair

419 Friday Nov 12th
 Fore part of this day fresh breezes from S.W.
 Steaming S.E. sun down light to the wind under
 lower Top sails so ends the day

420 Saturday Nov 13th
 This day commences with a moderate storm
 from N.W. ship under lower M-Top sail
 latter part more moderate ship under lower
 Top sails and Finbacks

421 Sunday Nov 14th
 This day fine weather from the Eastward
 ship under all sail steering off S.W.
 and one sail & Finbacks so ends the day
 under short sail by the wind, Wind N.E.

422 Monday Nov 15th
 Fore part of this day blowing a fresh gale
 from the N.W. ship on opposite tack under
 lower Top sail got out broad so ends the day
 more moderate and Finbacks

423 Tuesday Nov 16th
 This day commences with moderate weather from
 N.W. middle & latter part blowing a storm
 ship lying to under lower main top sail
