

Remarks on board Ship Eliza Adams

436 Monday November 27th Lat S Long W
Fore part of this day light S.W. with
much latter part blowing a storm from
N.E. Ship here to under lower M Top sail
also got out water

437 Tuesday Nov 28th
Fore part of this day blowing a storm
from N.E. at 2 P.M. hauled with
the ship & Viger latter part moderate from
the N.E. Steering N.W. by S. under short
sail

438 Wednesday December 1st
This day strong North winds with thick
fog ship heaving N.W. saw the
S.W. Viger latter part squally from

439 Thursday Dec 2nd
This 24 hours fresh strong breezes from
the Westward on opposite tack under all
sail the Viger in sight got out a Cask
of Bread so ends the day under short
sail

440 Friday Dec 3rd
This day fresh strong West winds with
fine weather under all sail steering to the
Eastward also the Viger employed fitting
the M-Top mast & stay so ends the
day under short sail by the wind

441 Saturday December 4th Lat S 64° 0' Long W
This day fresh breezes from the Westward
under full sail steering to the Eastward
all hauled with the Viger saw Fairbanks
latter part under short sail by the wind
heaving North

442 Sunday Dec 5th
Light pleasant weather from the Westward
ship under all sail heaving to the North
also the ship & Viger sun down took
in all but Lower Top sails

443 Monday Dec 6th
Fore part of this day fresh breezes from
the Northward under full sail steering of S.W.
sun down took in sail so ends the day by the
wind also the ship & Viger mended the J. Top
Gallant sail

444 Tuesday Dec 7th
This 24 hours strong North winds with
thick rainy foggy weather ship under lower
Top sails for opposite tack also the Viger
so ends the day

445 Wednesday Dec 8th
This 24 hours blowing a fresh sail from
S.W. ship under lower Top sails & Fore sail
on opposite tack also the Viger so ends the
day more moderate
