

Remarks on board Ship Eliza Adams

- 507 Wednesday February 9th ^{Leat} ^S
 This day light breeze from S.E. ^E
 under full sail ship off & on the
 wind weather pleasant latter part
 under lower top sails heading to the
 westward
- 508 Thursday Feb 10th
 This 24 hours light airs & calms from the
 westward so ends the day
- 509 Friday Feb 11th
 This 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E.
 under all sail steering N.W. got
 out water so ends under lower
 top sails heading to the westward
- 510 Saturday Feb 12th
 This day red the S.E. breeze strong
 ship under top sails steering to
 the N.W. latter part under lower
 top sails heading to the westward
- 511 Sunday Feb 13th
 This day weather moderate under all sail
 steering off to the N.W. so ends the
 day under lower top sails heading to
 the westward
- 512 Monday Feb 14th
 Light breeze under all sail heading to
 the southward employed bending 2nd
 handed sails lower main top sail
 and upper top sail and spanker
 sun down took in the light sails all so
 saw a sail so ends the day moderate

- 513 Tuesday February 15th ^{Leat} ^S
 For part of this day light fair with
 showers of rain under all sail steering
 off at 8 AM landed the Perry
 freight 10 P.M. so ends the day lying
 aback
- 514 Wednesday Feb 16th
 Light breeze under all sail steering
 off by N.W. also the Perry employed
 appearing the old top of sail so ends
 the day lying aback but in the light
 sails
- 515 Thursday Feb 17th
 Light pleasant weather from S.E.
 employed at various jobs at 3 P.M.
 landed the Perry so ends the day
 steering N.W. by N under top sails
- 516 Friday Feb 18th
 Light pleasant weather as above under
 all sail steering N.W. by N and
 2 sails sent up 12 M. for Mizen Royal
 yards also bent the main Royal sail
 so ends the day lying aback heading
 to the westward safe for back
- 517 Saturday Feb 19th
 This day fine pleasant weather from
 S.E. under all sail steering N.W.
 by N so ends the day lying aback
 heading to the westward
