

Remarks on board Bk. James Allen

- 55 Tuesday November 1st Lat $22^{\circ}40'$ S Long $48^{\circ}20'$ W
This day fresh breezes from N.E. steering S.W. by S. & S. saw one sail employed at ship duties
- 56 Wednesday Nov 2nd Lat $22^{\circ}30'$ S Long $47^{\circ}30'$ W
This day fresh breezes from N.E. steering S.W. by S. so ends the day calm employed making 1000 foot Boats to the main
- 57 Thursday Nov 3rd
This 24 hours light winds from S. S.E. steering S.W. with thick hazy weather employed the same as above
- 58 Friday Nov 4th Lat $25^{\circ}30'$ S Long $39^{\circ}15'$ W
This 24 hours light N.E. winds steering S.W. saw one sail
- 59 Saturday Nov 5th
This day squally with variable winds heading to the S.W. got out water and sugar
- 60 Sunday Nov 6th Lat $27^{\circ}40'$ S Long $42^{\circ}10'$ W
Fresh breezes from N.E. steering S.W. by S. saw 4 sails
- 61 Monday Nov 7th
This 24 hours strong breezes from N.E. steering S.W. by S. saw 2 sails set up the Boat and sent down F. & M. Royal yards so ends the day
- 62 Tuesday Nov 8th
For part of this day fresh breezes from N.E. steering S.W. by S. saw 2 sails so ends the day under lower T. Sails blowing a storm

- 63 Wednesday November 9th Lat $34^{\circ}00'$ S Long $48^{\circ}20'$ W
This 24 hours blowing a moderate gale from N.E. W heading S. Signalled a Lark Boat giving the Long 14 8 26 W so ends the day
- 64 Thursday Nov 10th
This 24 hours blowing a fresh gale from W.S.W. ship under lower T. Sails saw one sail so ends the day
- 65 Friday Nov 11th Lat $35^{\circ}50'$ S
This day strong breezes from the westward under full sail by the wind heading S. S.W. employed at ship duties
- 66 Saturday Nov 12th
Light air and calms heading to the S.W. Shinhack in sight
- 67 Sunday Nov 13th
This 24 hours light light Northwesterly winds steering S.W. man fell from the foreboom saved by hooking a Boat and also the life boat
- 68 Monday Nov 14th Lat $37^{\circ}24'$ S Long $50^{\circ}04'$ W
This 24 hours blowing strong from the southward saw 2 sails and rose 2 Right Whales at 6.30 A.M. W.B. got one and got him along side and at 7 P.M. finished putting so ends the day more moderate
- 69 Tuesday Nov 15th
Light air and calms boiling so ends the day
- 70 Wednesday Nov 16th
Light pleasant weather finished looking at 100 A.M. 45 bells from star
