- 155 Thursday February 9th ^{Long} Lat
This 24 hours Variable winds with sun
rain and the Horatio
- 156 Friday Feb 10th
This 24 hours blowing a storm from the
N.W. so ends the day
- 157 Saturday Feb 11th
Blowing a storm from the
N.W. so ends the day
- 158 Sunday Feb 12th
This day blowing a moderate
S.W. breeze so ends the
day with rainy weather
- 159 Monday Feb 13th
Strong variable winds saw the land and
sailed the Horatio
- 160 Tuesday Feb 14th
Light air from the Westward sailed
the Horatio and one other sail so ends the
day
- 161 Wednesday Feb 15th
Horatio in sight light air from the
Westward steering off to the Eastward
saw one sail and one steamer
- 162 Thursday Feb 16th
Fore part of this day had
light Westly winds saw the 2 Whalers
H. & Winthrop & Horatio at 12.30 P.M.
Rose Spinn Whales Lured the S. L. Boats
at 1.30 in chase returned on board at
6.50 with out success saw the Horatio
take a whale so ends the day blowing
fresh with it thick and rainy
the land in sight

- 163 Friday February 17th
This 24 hours fresh breezes from the S.W.
with sun thick rainy weather
saw the H. & Winthrop & one
merchandise ship at 12.30 P.M.
rose Spinn Whales coming to the windward
quench S. L. got one stuck him along side
and got the Head in so ends the day
- 164 Saturday Feb 18th
Strong South winds with sun rain got
through cutting at 9 A.M. and commenced
to sail at 3 P.M. saw the Horatio and
H. & Winthrop so ends the day
- 165 Sunday Feb 19th
Weather the same as above employed
bailing so ends the day
- 166 Monday Feb 20th
Weather the same as above on opposite
tacks finished bailing at 2 P.M. turning
up 66 bls so ends the day
- 167 Tuesday Feb 21th
This 24 hours had fresh South winds on
opposite tacks saw the Island and Horatio
& H. & Winthrop stowed the head oil down
saw Hump backs so ends the day
- 168 Wednesday Feb 22nd
This 24 hours kept fresh breezes from the
Westward saw the Horatio H. & Winthrop
finished stowing the oil 69 bls saw
the Island and Hump backs so ends the day
rainy
- 169 Thursday Feb 23rd
This 24 hours blowing a moderate S.W. breeze
from the Westward on opposite tacks
the Horatio in sight
