May 5th
Said Whales L.B. got one making
40 bls

May 9th
Said Whales L.B. got one making
68 bls

May 13th
Spoke the John & Winthrop nothing
since leaving Salcahuano

Friday May
Light N.E. Windy wind steering E.S. & for
John Forward of Boat went on shore at 3 P.M.
returned at 10 P.M.

Saturday May 27th
Light wind the Ship Horatio in sight
Nore a Spinnaker whale toward the Beasts
in chase also the Horatio lowered her
Boats the James Allen's B.B. got
the whale but he did not mate with the
Horatio whale making 86 bls.
