

Remarks on board Bk. of Allen

June 8th
Light pleasant weather rose Spinn
Whales L.B. got one making 85 lbs

June 14th
Weather not pleasant saw Whales
L.B. got one making 51 lbs also W.B.
struck and lost lines

June 15th
Blowing a moderate gale did not cut
in until the 16th

June 18th
Weather pleasant saw Whales S.B.
struck but lost her lines so ends the
day

June 20th
Employed stowing dunnage
Landed the boat for a whale thought
it a Spinn Whale but it proved
to be a humpback returned on
board and finished stowing dunnage

Tuesday July 4th Strong breeze from
S. Lat 32:00 N. W. under all sail on opposite tack
Long 82:30 Employed at ship's duties weather
sun thick and hazy

W.B. went on but
did not get last
Sunday July 6th
Weather pleasant the ship
Horatio in sight of W. W. W. rose
the Horatio with B. G. and
at 9 a.m. rose the Whales L.B. got one
and mated with the Horatio
L.B. got one and the Horatio got one
our whale making 90 lbs gave
the Horatio 15 lbs our whale making
53 lbs did not see the W. W. W. Tack

Weather pleasant from the Southward
the Horatio in sight and one merchant
ship also leaving South
dist 40 miles the burner of Allen rose
Spinn Whales L.B. got one the Horatio
mated with the Horatio Horatio got

Thursday August 24th
Light pleasant weather from the Southward
at 10 a.m. B. G. and B. W. also the Horatio
and the Capt on shore returned on board at
8 P.M. made all sail steering E. bound
to Valparaiso

Friday Aug 25th
Strong southerly wind under all sail
steering E. by S. also the Horatio saw
6 sails came away E. by S.

Saturday Aug 26th
Strong winds from the South under
top sails steering E. by S. sun down shorten
sail steering S. E. by E.

Sunday Aug 27th
Light pleasant weather from South
made the land at 8 a.m. N.E. raised
Valparaiso Light house at 2:30 P.M. bearing
N. by E. at 5 P.M. took in sail and ended
the day off to on all so the Horatio
saw 2 sails
