

Remarks on board Bk. James Allen

Monday August 28th
Strong breeze from the Southward
at 11 a.m. the Capt & wife went
on shore at Valparaiso & the Capt
of the Heratio so ends the day
off & on

Tuesday Aug 29th
Light breeze from the Southward
off & on at Valparaiso Capt &
W. Shore landed with the Heratio
so ends the day calm

Wednesday Aug 30th
This day commenced with light
breezes from all sides at all the
heights so ends the day Valparaiso
Light bearing S. by E. 20 miles at
E. P. M. so ends

Thursday Aug 31st
Fresh breeze from the Southward off &
on at 5.10 a.m. the Capt returned
on board by shore Boat so ends the
standing off shore

Friday September 1st
Light southerly wind all
day steering N. by W.

Saturday Sep 2nd
Light winds from the Southward
steering N.

Sunday Sep 3rd
Wind from the North under
short sail

Bound to Fairly
Monday Sep 4th
Light north winds with sun & rain
under short sail on opposite tacks

Tuesday Sep 5th
Light Northerly winds on opposite
tacks weather pleasant so ends the
day

Wednesday Sep 6th
This 24 hours fresh breeze from Southward
under all sail steering N. by W.

Thursday Sep 7th
This 24 hours fresh breeze from South
under all sail steering N. by W.

Friday Sep 8th
This 24 hours took the S. & E. trade light
under all sail steering North so ends
the day

Saturday Sep 9th
Fore part of this day had fresh breeze
from S. by E. by the wind heading
E. by N. latter part heading S. W. under
short sail weather overcast

Sunday Sep 10th
Light breeze steering N. W. & E. W.
Gained the Heratio

Monday Sep 11th
Light breeze weather overcast steering
N. W. & E. W. the Heratio in sight
