Monday January 1st ^{Lat} 53° 30' N
Light air from about south heading
4 to 8 Weather pleasant so ends
New year's day

Tuesday Jan 2nd
Moderate westerly from the Westward
Seering E

Wednesday Jan 3rd
Weather the same as above

Thursday Jan 4th
The same as before

Friday Jan 5th
Light westerly winds Gained the
Horatio & J. P. West so ends the
day moderate

Saturday Jan 6th
Light south winds saw the J. P. West
& Horatio also Huala Island in sight
so ends the day under best sail

Sunday Jan 7th
Strong breeze from the Southward
Sawed with the Bk Lancer at 12 30 P.M.
at 2 P.M. rose Spinn Whales going to
the windward Landed the first Whale
in Boat returned on board at 6 P.M.
with out success the J. P. West
& Horatio in sight

Monday Jan 8th
Light weather from the Southward

Ships in sight

Light westerly from the Southward

Friday Jan 19th
Strong breeze from the Southward
and squally. The Island of Huala
bearing S by E at 20 miles the J. P. West
and Horatio in sight and Lancer at
1 P.M. rose 20 Spinn Whales here
the J. L. Boat B B got one took him
along side 4 P.M. so ends the day heading
off shore under top sails towing the whale
