 B.B. chased on W.B. struck

 Whale along side at 10 P.M.
 so ends the day calm

Wednesday May 8th
 Strong breeze employed cutting
 finished at 7 P.M. Lured West
 blowing a fresh gale from North

Thursday May 9th
 Blowing a fresh gale from the N.W.
 started the works at 10 A.M.
 so ends the day blowing a moderate S
 gale

Friday May 10th
 Weather more moderate from the S.E.
 sailing

Saturday May 11th
 Weather the same as above sailing

Sunday May 12th
 Weather the same finished sailing
 at 7 A.M. and staved down the
 Head ail saw 2 sails

Monday May 13th
 Weather moderate finished staving
 down

Sunday July 15th
 Went on shore at Joan H also Garret
 the Lagada

Monday July 16th
 Weather thick with strong breeze from
 the N.W. Garret the Lagada off &
 on at Joan

Tuesday July 17th
 Weather quite pleasant from
 S.E. got off by lighter 6 Cords of
 Wood

Wednesday July 18th
 Weather moderate 2 Boats went in
 shore fishing returned on board at 5 P.M.

Thursday July 19th
 Weather pleasant from S.E. heading to the
 Estuaries

Friday July 20th
 Weather the same as above on opposite
 tack

Monday August 13th
 Weather moderate from N.W.
 at 9 A.M. rose Spinn Whales
 going to the windward Lured the Boats
 in chase and returned on board at
 4 P.M. with out success Mr. H.
 having about 8 Dist 60 miles

Tuesday August 14th
 Light pleasant weather from W.N.W.
 ship heading N by the wind under all
 sail saw a merchantship at 430 P.M.
 rose Spinn Whales 4 points off the
 weather Ban 3 miles off lured the boats
 and returned on board at dark with out success
