

Remarks on board. Bk. James Allen

Wednesday October 10th

Weather pleasant from South the
Capt came on board at 9 am and
Sailed from Salaghuano bound direct
South Whig Whaling

October 11th

Strong southerly saw the ship Herald

Thursday November 22nd

Light S.W. winds the J.P. West in
sight rose spinn Whales at 5th m
Landed the Boats at 6 am L.B.
shook abrd took the whale along side
at 3.30 P.M. also spoke the Bk J.P.
West so ends the day getting ready for
culling

Friday Nov 23rd

Employed Culling landed the case
at 6 P.M.

November 28 finished sparring
down 109 lbs also washed ship
and rose a large spinn Whale saw
him ere rising blowing a moderate
gale

Nov 30th

Light breeze from the South saw
Blackfish L.B. 1, W.B. 2, B.B. 1

December 1st

Gave the Bk J.P. West

Sunday

Dec 2nd

Loaded the Blackfish 5 lbs

December 12th

Strong breeze from South at 7.0 m
rose a large spinn Whale going to the
windward did not Lare saw the
J.P. West to the windward

Friday December 21st

Strong South wind at 12.30 P.M.
rose spinn Whales W.B. struck took
the whale along side at 5.30 P.M.
the Bk J.P. West in sight but saw
no place no boats

Saturday Dec 22

Light southerly winds Employed culling
at 4.0 P.M. rose spinn Whales
coming to the windward Landed L.B.
and W.B. did not strike whales going
quick to windward said the J.P. West
Lore her Boat Landed the case at
6 P.M.

Dec 26th

Light pleasant weather from South
finished boiling at 1 P.M. 122 lbs
