Thursday Jan 9th

This day commences with light winds from the Eastward and frequent squalls of rain middle and latter parts light winds from S.E. and squally weather Course S. by W. all hands employed in ship's duty Lat 00° 24' North

Monday Jan 10th

This day commences with a strong wind from the East and accompanied by a heavy squall of rain at 12 past one P.M. hauled down the fly jib clewed up the fore-top gallant-sail and furled them clewed up the main top gallant sail hauled up the gaff-top sail and main sail wind from E.N.E. altered our course to S.E. middle and latter parts calms and squalls of rain all hands employed in ship's duty

Tuesday Jan 11th

This day commences with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather middle part light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather at eight A.M. sent down the fore-top gallant sail and fore-top gallant yard at ten A.M. raised a sail off our starboard quarter all hands employed in ship's duty fitting fore-top gallant sail & yard Lat 00° 31' South

Wednesday Jan 12th

This day commences with strong winds from S.E. and pleasant weather at three P.M. sent up the fore-top gallant yard and sail and set it at six a barque overhauled us and set English Colors middle part strong winds from S.E. and squally at ten P.M. hauled down the fly jib at one A.M. clewed up the fore and main top gallant sails at two hauled up the main sail gaff-top sail and

spanker at four A.M. set the main sail at six A.M. set the top gallant sails spanker gaff-top sail ship heading S.W. all hands employed in ship's duty Lat 2° 37' S.

Thursday Jan 13th

This day commences with strong winds from S.E. and pleasant weather at four P.M. set the fly jib middle part strong winds from South E. and pleasant weather at ten hauled down the fly jib at twelve set it again latter part strong winds from S.E. and pleasant weather all hands employed in ship's duty ship heading S.W. Lat 4° 34' S.

Friday Jan 14th

This day commences with strong winds from S.E. and pleasant weather at one P.M. saw two sails off our lee quarter middle and latter parts strong winds from S.E. and pleasant weather at one P.M. took in the fly jib and gaff-top sail at five A.M. set them again all hands employed in ship's duty ship heading S.W. by S. Lat 6° 55' S.

Saturday Jan 15th

This day commences with pleasant weather and wind from S.E. at five P.M. tacked ship and stood to the Eastward at six had a squall which headed her off tacked again and headed S.W. took in the fly jib middle and latter parts strong south East trade winds veering and hauling about three points ship heading S.S.W. all hands employed in ship's duty Lat 8° 45' S.

Sunday Jan 16th

This day commences with fine breezes from S.E. and pleasant weather middle part moderate breezes from S.E. and squally weather at nine P.M. took in the fly jib at 12 past nine fore-top gallant sail and gaff-top sail at ten P.M. hauled up the main sail and spanker at eleven P.M. set them at twelve hauled them up again at five set them and the fore-top gallant sail gaff-top sail and fly jib Lat 10° 32' S.
