

Remarks on board

Saturday Feb 12th

This day commences with fine winds from E. and pleasant weather middle and latter parts light winds from N. and pleasant weather at 8 A.M. put the ship on the other tack and headed E. by N. at nine A.M. took in fly jib and hoisted up the main sail all hands employed in ordinary work Lat 32° 57' South

Sunday Feb 13th

This day commences with light winds from S. by E. and pleasant weather ship by the wind E. by N. middle and latter parts light winds from S. by E. and pleasant weather all hands employed in ordinary ships duty and looking out for whales Lon 68° 40' W. Lat 32° 56' S.

Monday Feb 14th

This day commences with light winds and pleasant weather at three P.M. the wind hauled to N. N. W. and pleasant weather middle and latter parts no wind at eleven A.M. saw a school of sperm whales all hands employed in ordinary work Lat 32° 12' S.

Tuesday Feb 15th

This day commences with light winds from N. N. W. and pleasant weather at one P.M. lowered chasers but got nothing middle and latter parts light wind from N. E. and pleasant weather ship by the wind heading E. S. E. all hands employed in ships duty

Wednesday Feb 16th

This day commences with light winds from N. E. and pleasant weather at sun set took in sail middle and latter parts light winds from N. E. by E. and pleasant weather at sun rise made sail again tacked ship and headed N. W. all hands employed in ships duty Lon 5° 14' W. Lat 32° 58' S.

Thursday Feb 17th

This day commences with light wind from N. E. by N. and pleasant weather at sun set took in sail middle and latter parts light winds from N. and pleasant weather at sun rise made sail again tacked ship and headed E. at eleven A.M. squared the yards

and kept the ship S. E. by S. all hands employed in ordinary work Lat 31° 42' South

Friday Feb 18th

This day commences with fine wind from N. N. W. and pleasant weather at sun set shortened sail at eleven P.M. the wind hauled around to S. W. and a heavy squall latter part strong wind and thick weather at six A.M. set double reefed top sails and jib at eight A.M. took in fore top sail and jib close reefed the main top sail and buffed the ship by the wind and headed S. by E. all hands employed in ordinary work Lat 31° 42' S.

Saturday Feb 19th

This day commences with strong winds from S. S. W. and thick squally at six P.M. wore ship and stood to the westward at six A.M. wore ship again and headed S. W. by E. middle and latter parts strong winds from S. S. W. thick and squally weather Lat 31° 42' S.

Sunday Feb 20th

This day commences with strong winds from S. S. W. and squally weather at seven P.M. wore ship and stood to the westward middle and latter parts strong winds from S. and pleasant weather at six A.M. set double reefed top sails and jib wore ship and headed S. W. by E. at eleven saw a French barge standing to the northward and eastward Lon 6° 20' W. Lat 31° 12' South

Monday Feb 21st

This day commences with strong winds S. by W. and pleasant weather at six P.M. wore ship and headed N. E. took in fore top sail and jib middle and latter parts light wind from S. and pleasant weather at six A.M. made all sail again ship steering by the wind heading E. S. E. all hands employed in ships duty Lat 31° 13' S.

Tuesday Feb 22nd

This day commences with light winds from S. and pleasant weather at five P.M. wind hauled W. by S. at sunset took in sail middle and latter parts light baffling winds and squally weather at seven took
