

Remarks on board

Tuesday Mar 15th

This day commences with strong wind from S. E. and pleasant weather at five tacked ship and stood to the southward and westward middle and latter part wind from S. by E. and pleasant weather at two A. M. tacked ship and headed E. by S. all hands employed in ships duty
Lon 12° 4' 30" E. Lat 33° 40' S.

Wednesday Mar 16th

This day commences with strong wind from S. by E. and pleasant weather middle and latter parts strong wind from S. and pleasant weather at five A. M. tacked ship and stood to the W. ward all hands employed in ships duty Lat 33° 46' S.

Thursday Mar 17th

This day commences with strong wind from S. and pleasant weather at four tacked ship and stood to the Eastward middle and latter parts strong wind from south and pleasant weather at ten A. M. tacked ship again and headed W. by S. all hands employed in ships duty Lat 33° 40' S.

Friday Mar 18th

This day commences with moderate winds S. by W. and pleasant weather middle and latter parts light winds from S. W. and pleasant weather at two wind hauled to W. S. W. tacked ship headed south all hands employed in ships duty Lon 13° 55' E. Latitude 34° 22' S.

Saturday Mar 19th

This day commences with strong wind from W. and pleasant weather at twelve squared the yards and kept the ship S. S. E. and set the fore top gallant sail and fore top mast studding sail middle and latter parts strong winds from W. and squally weather at two A. M. hauled down fore top mast studding sails top gallant sails and double reefed the top sails at four made

sail again shipspourse S. E. all hands employed in ships duty Lon 16° 47' 30" E. Lat 35° 46' S.

Sunday Mar 20th

This day commences with strong winds from S. W. and pleasant weather Course S. E. middle and latter parts calm at two A. M. took in the top gallant sails and fore top mast studding sail at seven A. M. set them again at eleven breeze sprung up from N. W. all hands employed in ships duty Lon 18° 2' 30" E. Lat 35° 58' S.

This day commences with moderate wind from N. W. and pleasant weather at one P. M. hauled up the spraker middle and latter parts strong winds from N. N. W. and pleasant weather at eight A. M. took in the fore top mast studding sail at nine A. M. split the main sail and unbent it Course S. E. by E. all hands employed in ships duty Latitude 36° 26' South

Wednesday Mar 22nd

This day commences with strong wind from S. W. and squally weather at one P. M. took in the fore and main top gallant sails at two double reefed the top sails and furled the jib at six P. M. took in fore top sail and close reefed the main top sail middle and latter parts strong wind from N. N. W. and clear weather at two set double reefed main top sail at six spoke reefs out main top sail and set main top gallant sail and unbent the fore top sail at eleven A. M. sent it aloft and set it again and the fore top gallant sail course S. E. by E. all hands employed in ships duty Lon 24° 21' E. Lat 36° 21' S.

Thursday Mar 23rd

This day commences with moderate wind from W. and pleasant weather at one P. M. bent a new main sail course S. E. middle and latter parts strong wind from N. E. and hazy weather at eight took in the fore top gallant sail at ten P. M. took in the main top gallant sail Lon 27° 33' E. Lat 36° 46' S.
