

Remarks on board

Thursday Mar 24th

This day commences with strong wind from N.E. and pleasant weather at two P.M. set the top gallant sails at four P.M. wind hauled to N.W. and we set the fore top mast studding sail middle and latter parts strong winds from N.W. and pleasant weather at eight P.M. took in fore top mast studding sail and fore top gallant sail at nine had a squall and took in main top gallant sail and fore top sail and close reefed the main top sail at ten P.M. set the main top sail double reefed Course E.S.E. all hands employed in ships duty Lon 31° 40' E. Lat. 37° 05' S.

Friday Mar 25th

This day commences with ~~perd~~ strong winds from N.W. and pleasant weather ship scudding under close reefed main top sail and fore sail middle and latter parts strong winds from N.W. and pleasant weather at eleven P.M. set close reefed fore top sail and double reefed main top sail at six AM at set the top sails and main top gallant sail at seven A.M. set the fore top gallant sail and fore top mast studding sail at eleven A.M. set main top gallant studding sail Longitude 35° 4' 15" E Latitude 37° 35' S.

Saturday Mar 26th

This day commences with strong winds from N.W. and pleasant weather at two P.M. took a squall which split our maintop sail at the sail but the fore sail and main top sail being furled at three P.M. set the fore top sail and sent down the main top sail and sent up a new one course S.E. by E middle and latter parts light wind from south west and pleasant weather at eight set the fore and main top gallant sails at ten A.M. sent out the fore top mast studding sail course S.E. all hands employed in ships duty Longitude 38° 32' E Lat 37° 55' S.

Sunday Mar 27th

This day commences with light wind from S.W. and pleasant weather at one set the main top gallant studding sail at three P.M. took in the studding sails and braced the yards middle and latter parts strong wind from N.N.E. and pleasant weather at nine P.M. tack ed ship and headed S. at ten A.M. took in fore and main top gallant sails at eleven A.M. single reefed the top sails Lat 38° 20' S.

Monday Mar 28th

This day commences with strong wind from N.N.E. and pleasant weather at three P.M. set the top gallant sails middle and latter parts strong wind from N. by E and pleasant weather at twelve took in the top gallant sails at six A.M. set the top gallant sail all hands employed in ships duty Lat 38° 20' S.

Tuesday Mar 29th

This day commences with moderate wind from N.E. ship steering S.E. at three P.M. unbent the gaff top sail and bent another one middle and latter parts strong wind from N. and pleasant weather ship's course E.S.E. and at seven A.M. set the fore top mast studding sail Lon 48° 3' E Lat 38° 30' S.

Wednesday Mar 30th

This day commences with strong wind from N.N.W. and pleasant weather at two P.M. set main top gallant studding sail middle and latter parts strong wind from N.N.W. and pleasant weather course S.E. by E at ten P.M. set took in main top gallant studding sail at twelve set it again all hands employed in setting up main stays Lon 52° 14' 50" E. Lat 38° 31' S.

Thursday Mar 31th

This day commences with moderate wind from N. by W. and pleasant weather ship steering S.E. by E under all sail middle and latter parts strong wind N.N.E. and pleasant weather all hands employed in ships duty Lon 56° 53' E. Lat 38° 33' South
