

# Remarks on board,

Tuesday Apr 26<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with light wind from the E. and pleasant weather at five P.M. tacked ship and headed N.N.E. middle part light wind from E. and pleasant weather at two A.M. the wind hauled ahead tacked ship and headed S.E. latter part light wind from N.E. and pleasant weather ship by the wind heading E.S.E. at eleven saw several fin back whales and lowered for them but did not strike.

Wednesday Apr 27<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with light wind from N.E. and pleasant weather ship by the wind heading E. by S. middle and latter parts strong wind from N.N.W. and pleasant weather ship heading N.E. and steering by the wind Lon 108° 48' E. Lat 32° 36' S.

Thursday Apr 28<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with light wind from N.N.E. and pleasant weather ship by the wind heading E. at six P.M. took in sail for the night middle part light wind from W. and pleasant weather latter part light wind from E.W. and hazy weather at seven made sail and steered N.E. at 11 past eleven altered our course to N.

Friday Apr 29<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with light wind from the S. and hazy weather ship steering north middle and latter parts light wind from W. and pleasant weather course N. at eleven A.M. the wind died away to a calm Lon 108° 58' 45" E. Lat 31° 07' S.

Saturday Apr 30<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with calm and pleasant weather at six P.M. took in sail for the night middle and latter part calm and pleasant weather at six A.M. made sail again at nine A.M. a breeze sprang up from E. by S. ship headed N.E. at tenth tacked ship headed N.N.W. Lat 30° 58' S

# Barque Elizabeth

May 1<sup>st</sup>

This day commences with light wind from the N. and pleasant weather ship by the wind heading W.N.W. at six P.M. took in sail for the night wore ship and headed E.N.E. middle and latter parts baffling winds and pleasant weather at seven made sail ship heading N.N.W. at twelve tacked ship and stood to the westward Lat 31° 48' S

May 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day commences with calms and light winds from the westward ship heading N. at five took in sail for the night middle and latter parts light wind from W.N.W. and pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading N. at seven made sail again all hands employed in ship's duty Lat 29° 46' S.

May 3<sup>rd</sup>

This day commences with light winds from W.N.W. and pleasant weather at six P.M. took in sail for the night middle and latter parts light from the W. and pleasant weather at seven A.M. made sail and kept her N. Lon 108° 25' 15" E. Lat 28° 25' S.

May 4<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with light wind from W.N.W. and pleasant weather ship steering N. at five took in all sail for the night middle and latter parts light wind from S.E. and pleasant weather ship steering N. at seven A.M. made sail again and altered her course to N.W. at seven saw a ship of our lee bow standing to the west at eight A.M. altered our course to N.W. Lat 27° 14' South

May 5<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with moderate wind from S.E. and pleasant weather ship steering W.N.W. at two P.M. got down and spoke the ship hunters of New Bedford and went on board of her at seven came on board our ship again and took in sail as usual middle and latter
