Tuesday May 31st

This day commenced with moderate wind from the southward and eastward weather squally at five P.M. shortened sail for the night middle and latter parts moderate wind from the southward and eastward clear and pleasant weather ship by the wind with her starboard tacks aboard at sixth made sail at nine got an altitude Lon Lat

Wednesday June 1st

This day commenced with light bafflin winds and calms this day all hands employed in water in the ship at five shortened sail for the night hoisted around the yards ship by the wind heading to the southward middle part wind from the southward and eastward cloudy weather at six A.M. made sail latter part wind from the southward tack ship headed S. Lat

Thursday June 2nd

This day commenced with strong wind from the northward and eastward cloudy weather ship by the wind at two P.M. spoke the Arab New Bedford at six shortened sail for the night middle part moderate wind from the southward and eastward rainy weather at six A.M. made sail latter part strong wind from the southward and eastward cloudy weather — starboard tacks aboard Lat

Friday June 3rd

This day commenced with strong wind from the southward and eastward and then cloudy ship by the wind with her starboard tacks aboard at six P.M. tacked
