Wednesday June 8th

This day commences with strong wind from the southward and eastward clear and pleasant weather at three P.M. raised whale tacked ship middle part light wind from the E. ship by the wind with her larboard tacks aboard latter part moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant Lat

Thursday June 9th

This day commences with light wind from the northward at one P.M. steered S.E. at six shortened sail for the night and steered S.W. middle part light wind from the northward and pleasant latter part light wind from the northward and pleasant at six made sail and kept the ship E. Lat

Friday June 10th

This day commences with light wind from the northward at one P.M. altered her course to S. land in sight ahead and a sail at six P.M. lapped the ship by the wind with her starboard tacks aboard and shortened sail for the night middle and latter parts light wind from the northward and cloudy at six made sail Lat

Saturday June 11th

This day commences with light wind from the northward at two the wind suddenly changed to the southward braced around the yards and saw a sail to windward coming down for us spoke her (Clifford Mackerel) 14 miles out 900 sperm at six shortened sail for the

Sunday June 12th

This day commences with moderate wind from the southward at one P.M. raised a school of black fish lowered and took one at six P.M. tacked ship and took in sail for the night middle part moderate wind from the southward and pleasant ship by the wind with her larboard tacks aboard at three A.M. wore ship at six A.M. made sail Lat

Monday June 13th

This day commences with moderate wind from the southward and fine weather at one P.M. got a lumen at three raised a school of black fish but did not get any at four P.M. raised a sperm whale lowered but did not get him at five took in top gallant sails for the night middle part light wind from the southward and fine weather ship by the wind with her starboard tacks aboard at three A.M. wore ship latter part light winds and calms clear and pleasant weather Lat

Tuesday June 14th

This day commences with light winds and calms at two got a lumen at five put the ship under double reefed topsails middle part light winds and calms ship by the wind with her larboard tacks aboard at four A.M. braced around the yards with a light wind from S.W. and steered her south latter part calms Lat
