

Remarks on board
at seven A.M. tacked ship latter part strong
wind from the eastward Lon. Lat.

Friday June 24th

This day commences with strong wind
from the eastward and pleasant weather
ship by the wind with her starboard tacks
aboard at three P.M. got an altitude mid
dle part strong wind from the eastward
at twelve tacked ship at six A.M. tacked
again so ends this day Lon. Lat.

Saturday June 25th

This day commences with moderate
wind from the eastward and pleasant
weather at one P.M. wore ship and heads
to the northward and eastward at three P.M.
got an altitude middle part strong wind
eastward latter part more moderate at
five tacked ship Lon. Lat.

Sunday June 26th

This day commences with moderate
wind from the eastward at three wore
ship and it died away calm cleared away
our anchors and at five let them go in
nine fathoms water middle part calm
at twelve a breeze from the southward
at one called all hands and got under way
and steered N.E. latter part wind to
the eastward ship by the wind with her
starboard tacks aboard at twelve tacked
ship Lon. Lat.

Monday June 27th

This day commences with moderate
wind from the eastward and pleasant
weather at three got an altitude at four
lowered for a hump back but did not
get him at six let go our anchors
in twelve fathoms water middle part

light winds and cloudy latter part calm at
five A.M. called all hands manned two boats
to survey the harbour Lon. Lat.

Tuesday June 28th

This day commences with light wind and
pleasant weather at one boat came aboard
got under way and steered N.E. at five
let go our anchor again in twelve fathoms
over water turtle island bearing S.E. by S
distance eight miles middle part light winds
and calms at twelve a breeze from the
southward and eastward at three began
to drag call all hands got under way with
double reefed topsails and steered N. by W.
latter part strong wind shook reef out
the topsails Lon. Lat.

Wednesday June 29th

This day commences with strong wind
from the southward and eastward clear
and pleasant weather course N. by W.
middle part strong winds from the southward
and eastward at twelve altered her course to
N.E. by N. wind increasing at four P.M.
ship under double reefed topsails latter part
moderate gales at twelve close reefed the
topsails and luffed by the wind Lon. Lat.

Thursday June 30th

This day commences with moderate gales
from the southward and eastward at four
shook one reef out the topsails middle and
latter parts strong winds from the south
ward and eastward ship by the wind with
her starboard tacks aboard Lon. Lat.

Friday July 1st

This day commences with strong wind
and pleasant weather at three got an
altitude middle and latter parts strong wind
