Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup>  
This day begins with strong wind from  
the eastward and clear weather ship by  
the wind with her starboard tack aboard  
at three got an altitude middle and latter  
parts strong wind from the eastward  
ship under reefed topsails Lon Lat

Sunday July 3<sup>rd</sup>  
This day commenced with easterly winds  
and pleasant weather at two P.M. wore ship  
at three got an altitude middle and latter  
parts strong wind from the eastward  
at two ship wore ship and headed to  
the northward and eastward Lat

Monday July 4<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with more  
moderate wind from the eastward  
at three P.M. got an altitude middle  
and latter parts strong wind from the  
southward and eastward ship by the wind  
with her starboard tack aboard Lon Lat

Tuesday July 5<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with strong wind  
from the southward and eastward at  
one P.M. raised land off our lee bow at  
six P.M. tacked ship middle and latter  
part more moderate at three A.M. tacked  
ship at nine got a lunar at ten raised  
land off weather bow Lon Lat

Wednesday July 6<sup>th</sup>  
The first part more moderate at one tacked  
ship and headed southward and to the  
eastward middle and latter parts moderate  
wind from the eastward and pleasant  
weather Lat

Thursday July 7<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with moderate wind  
from the eastward and pleasant weather  
at two got an altitude middle and latter parts  
moderate wind from the eastward and  
pleasant weather at nine A.M. raised a  
large sperm whale lowered the boat  
and commenced harpooning Lat 140 18

Friday July 8<sup>th</sup>  
This day at four P.M. fastened to the whale  
and drew and lost him middle and latter  
parts light wind from the southward and east-  
ward clear and pleasant weather at ten P.M.  
tacked ship ship by the wind with her star-  
board tack aboard at ten A.M. got an  
altitude Lon Lat

Saturday July 9<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with light wind from  
E.S.E. and pleasant weather at three got  
an altitude middle and latter parts moderate  
wind from the southward and eastward  
at five A.M. set for top mast tiding sail and  
steered S.E. by S. at six raised a trail stand-  
ing to the southward Lon Lat

Sunday July 10<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with a southeasterly  
wind and pleasant weather at three  
got an altitude course N.N.E. strong wind  
from the southward and eastward at twelve  
wore ship at three wore again and at five  
raised land off our weather bow so ends  
this day Lon Lat

Monday July 11<sup>th</sup>  
Strong wind from the eastward the  
first part of this day ship by the wind  
with her starboard tack aboard  
middle part strong wind of the land latter
