part calm at six o'clock raised a sail in shore
at nine Capt. went on board Lat

Tuesday June 12th
This day commenced with moderate
wind and pleasant weather at five
o'clock came on board and reported her
to be the Griffin London 35 tons out
12 sp. 550 lbs. ashore general middle
part strong wind off the land latter
part calm Lat

Wednesday July 13th
This day commenced with a fine
sea breeze at four P.M. raised battens
middle part galley latter part a fine breeze
from the S.W. Lat

Thursday July 14th
Commenced with a fine breeze at
four o'clock the Woodlark London 24 tons
out 1000 sp. middle part light land
breeze latter part wind S.W. Lat

Friday July 15th
This day commenced with fine weather
as usual ship sailing along Baymore shore
for Antirra middle and latter parts
moderate wind and pleasant weather
at ten o'clock let go our anchor at Antirra

Saturday July 16th
This day all hands employed in recruiting
wooding and watering ship middle
pleasant latter part all hands employed
in ordinary work in Port

Sunday July 17th
The first part of this day all hands
wooding watering and ordinary work
on board middle part pleasant latter
part anchored each went on shore
on liberty

Monday July 18th
First part lashed and wash ashore on
on liberty middle part pleasant latter
part all hands employed in wooding
watering and recruiting ship

Tuesday July 19th
This day commenced with pleasant
weather at two the Massachusetts Sanbuck
sent her boat aboard 11 tons out 200
sp at four Edward Cary Sanbuck 9 tons
out 250 sp

Wednesday July 20th
First part of this day all hands employed
in recruiting ship middle part pleasant
latter part recruiting ship

Thursday July 21st
This day commenced with a strong sea
breeze at two ship began to drag let go
our second anchor at five commenced
heaving shot at eight hour shot and
sent all hands below at one o'clock called
all hands and masted the mizzen at four
underway bound for Cuthia

Friday July 22nd
This day commenced with a fine sea
breeze at two P.M. sent two boats ashore
at Cuthia for recruits at seven boats
came aboard middle part strong land breeze
latter part sent two boats ashore at Antirra

Saturday July 23rd
At three P.M. boats came aboard braced
forward main yard and stood down the
straits along Baymore shore

Sunday July 24th
This day commenced with light wind
and pleasant weather middle and latter
parts strong winds and pleasant
